Traditionally after dinner, champagne is poured and the Best Man, Maid/Matron of Honor, and/or other pre-selected speakers will make a toast. When ready to do the toast please let the DJ know and he will announce for everyone to be seated and give the speaker a microphone. Notes:

After the toast, the DJ will resume the Background Music.
